The will of God is one person--Christ; one way--the cross; and one goal--the church as the Body of Christ and the one new man. In Message 12 we see that we need to know and experience Christ as our kingly and divine High Priest according to the order of Melchizedek. As the King, He has the scepter to rule over the earth and to manage our affairs, and as the High Priest, He is interceding for us and taking care of our case

Hence, the seven golden lampstands are the enlarged, corporate expression of the Triune God. In Message 15 we see that Christ is the Lamb

The highest point in our spiritual experience is having a clear sky with God's throne above it;
